During our daily Liturgies, the priests will be praying for the health and well-being of all the Orthodox Christians of our Parish, as well as, the deceased members of our Church. We will also be asking God to keep us all from the influence of evil in these challenging days of our time.

Orthros will start at 7:30 a.m. and Divine Liturgy at 8:30 am. daily, except Wednesdays ONLY, when the service will begin at 6:30 pm., in the evening. We will offer an evening Liturgy to allow those who work to also participate.




