EPISTLE READING

The reading is from St. Paul's Letter to the Col. 3:4 - 11

In those days, many signs and wonders were done among the people by the hands of the apostles. And they were all together in Solomon's Portico. None of the rest dared join them, but the people held them in high honor. And more than ever believers were added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women, so that they even carried out the sick into the streets, and laid them on beds and pallets, that as Peter came by at least his shadow might fall on some of them. The people also gathered from the towns around Jerusalem, bringing the sick and those afflicted with unclean spirits, and they were all healed. But the high priest rose up and all who were with him, that is, the party of the Sadducees, and filled with jealousy they arrested the apostles and put them in the common prison. But at night an angel of the Lord opened the prison doors and brought them out and said, "Go and stand in the temple and speak to the people all the words of this Life."

Οὔσης ὀψίας τῆ ἡμέρα ἐκείνη τῆ μιᾶ τῶν σαββάτων, καὶ τῶν θυρῶν κεκλεισμένων ὅπου ἦσαν οἱ μαθηταὶ συνηγμένοι διὰ τὸν φόβον τῶν Ἰουδαίων, ἤλθεν ὁ Ἰησοῦς καὶ ἔστη εἰς τὸ μέσον, καὶ λέγει αὐτοῖς- εἰρήνη ὑμῖν. καὶ τοῦτο εἰπὼν ἔδειξεν αὐτοῖς τὰς χεῖρας καὶ τὴν πλευρὰν αὐτοῦ. ἐχάρησαν οὖν οἱ μαθηταὶ ἰδόντες τὸν Κύριον. εἴπεν οὖν αὐτοῖς ὁ Ἰησοῦς πάλιν- εἰρήνη ὑμῖν. καθὼς ἀπέσταλκέ με ὁ πατήρ, κἀγὼ πέμπω ὑμᾶς. καὶ τοῦτο εἰπὼν ἐνεφύσησε καὶ λέγει αὐτοῖς· λάβετε Πνεύμα Άγιον· ἄν τινων ἀφῆτε τὰς ἁμαρτίας, ἀφίενται αὐτοῖς, ἄν τινων κρατῆτε, κεκράτηνται. Θωμᾶς δὲ εἴς ἐκ τῶν δώδεκα, ὁ λεγόμενος Δίδυμος, οὐκ ἦν μετ' αὐτῶν ὅτε ἦλθεν ὁ Ἰησοῦς. ἔλεγον οὖν αὐτῷ οἱ ἄλλοι μαθηταί· ἑωράκαμεν τὸν Κύριον. ὁ δὲ εἴπεν αὐτοῖς· ἐὰν μὴ ἴδω ἐν ταῖς χερσὶν αὐτοῦ τὸν τύπον τῶν ἥλων, καὶ βάλω τὸν δάκτυλόν μου εἰς τὸν τύπον τῶν ἥλων, καὶ βάλω τὴν χεῖρά μου εἰς τὴν πλευρὰν αὐτοῦ, οὐ μὴ πιστεύσω. Καὶ μεθ' ἡμέρας ὀκτὼ πάλιν ἦσαν ἔσω οί μαθηταὶ αὐτοῦ καὶ Θωμᾶς μετ' αὐτῶν. ἔρχεται ὁ Ἰησοῦς τῶν θυρῶν κεκλεισμένων, καὶ ἔστη εἰς τὸ μέσον καὶ εἴπεν· εἰρήνη ὑμῖν. εἴτα λέγει τῷ Θωμᾶ· φέρε τὸν δάκτυλόν σου ὧδε καὶ ἴδε τὰς χεῖράς μου, καὶ φέρε τὴν χεῖρά σου καὶ βάλε εἰς τὴν πλευράν μου, καὶ μὴ γίνου ἄπιστος, ἀλλὰ πιστός. καὶ ἀπεκρίθη Θωμᾶς καὶ εἴπεν αὐτῷ· ὁ Κύριός μου καὶ ὁ Θεός μου. λέγει αὐτῷ ὁ Ἰησοῦς· ὅτι έωρακάς με, πεπίστευκας· μακάριοι οί μὴ ἰδόντες καὶ πιστεύσαντες. Πολλὰ μὲν οὖν καὶ ἄλλα σημεία ἐποίησεν ὁ Ἰησοῦς ἐνώπιον τῶν μαθητῶν αὐτοῦ, ἃ οὐκ ἔστι γεγοαμμένα ἐν τῷ βιβλίῳ τούτω· ταῦτα δὲ γέγοαπται ἵνα πιστεύσητε ὅτι Ἰησοῦς ἐστιν ὁ Χοιστὸς ὁ υίὸς τοῦ Θεοῦ, καὶ ἵνα πιστεύοντες ζωὴν ἔχητε ἐν τῷ ὀνόματι αὐτοῦ.

The Gospel According to Jn. 20:19 – 31

On the evening of that day, the first day of the week, the doors being shut where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said to them, "Peace be with you." When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, even so I send you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them, and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained." Now Thomas, one of the twelve, called the Twin, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see in his hands the print of the nails, and place my finger in the mark of the nails, and place my hand in his side, I will not believe." Eight days later, his disciples were again in the house, and Thomas was with them. The doors were shut, but Jesus came and stood among them, and said, "Peace be with you." Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here, and see my hands; and put out your hand, and place it in my side; do not be faithless, but believing." Thomas answered him, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to him, "Haye you believed because you haye seen me? Blessed are those who haye not seen and yet believe." Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in his name.



ΤΡΕΙΣ ΑΡΝΗΣΕΙΣ: ΠΕΤΡΟΣ, ΙΟΥΔΑΣ, ΘΩΜΑΣ Στήν ιστορία αὐτῶν πού ἀκολούθησαν τόν Χριστό ὑπῆρξαν ἀρκετές περιπτώσεις ἀνθρώπων πού σέ μιά στιγμή ἀδυναμίας λύγισαν. Τά γεγονότα γύρω ἀπό τό πάθος καί τήν Ἀνάσταση τοῦ Κυρίου, πού ἐντονότερα ζωντάνεψαν μέσα μας οἱ τελευταῖες έβδομάδες, μᾶς θύμισαν τρεῖς χαρακτηριστικές ἐπώνυμες περιπτώσεις: τήν κάμψη τοῦ Πέτρου, τήν πτώση τοῦ Ἰούδα, τήν «καλή», ὅπως ὀνομάζεται, ἀπιστία τοῦ Θωμᾶ. Ἡ κάμψη τοῦ Πέτρου ἠταν μιά ἔμφαση άδυναμίας, μιά συνέπεια τῆς ὑπερβολικῆς ἐμπιστοσύνης στήν ἀφοσίωσή του στόν Διδάσκαλο. Ή πτώση τοῦ Τούδα είχε ἀφορμή τήν σύγχυση καί τήν φιλαργυρία. Διαφορετικά είχε φαντασθεῖ τόν Μεσσία· κι όταν διαπίστωσε ότι ὁ πραγματικός Χριστός δέν ἔμοιαζε στό εἴδωλο πού εἶγε πλάσει μέ τό μυαλό του, θυσίασε μέ τήν προδοσία του τήν Άλήθεια καί ὄχι τήν ψευδαίσθησή του. Τόν Θωμᾶ τόν σταμάτησε ή συρροή τῶν τελευταίων θλιβερῶν γεγονότων καί ἀναζήτησε τόν Θεό στά ὅρια τῶν λογικῶν αἰσθήσεων. Καί στίς τρεῖς περιπτώσεις ὁ Κύριος, ὅπως γνωρίζουμε, ἐπεμβαίνει προσωπικά. Τό ξέσπασμα τῆς πίστεως Στήν περίπτωση τοῦ Θωμᾶ, ἔφθασε ἡ ἀπλή παρουσία τοῦ Κυρίου γιά νά τόν συνεφέρει καί νά τόν άποκαταστήσει στήν πρώτη του σχέση καί έμπιστοσύνη. Ὁ Θωμᾶς εἶχε ἀποσυρθεῖ στήν μόνωση γιά νά βρεῖ τόν ἑαυτό του. Η λύση ὅμως τοῦ προβλήματος πού τόν ἀπασχολεῖ δέν πραγματοποιεῖται στήν μοναζιά του, άλλά διά τῆς ἐπιστροφῆς του στήν κοινότητα τῶν Μαθητῶν. Ἐκεῖ ὁ Ἰησοῦς τόν συναντᾶ καί όχι στό μέρος πού ήταν ἀπομονωμένος. Έρχεται μέσα στήν κοινότητα τῶν Ἀποστόλων, στήν Ἐκκλησία, ἀλλά γιά νά τόν συναντήσει προσωπικά. Καί τοῦ λέει: «Φέρε τόν δάκτυλό σου ἐδῷ καί κοίταξε τά χέρια μου καί φέρε τό γέρι σου καί βάλε το στήν πλευρά μου καί μή γίνεσαι ἄπιστος, άλλά πιστός». Ό ἀπόστολος Θωμᾶς ἀμέσως ἀνταποκρίνεται στήν προσταγή - παράκληση τοῦ Κυρίου καί, πρίν ἀκόμη ψηλαφίσει τόν Χριστό, ξεσπᾶ σέ ὁμολογία πίστεως: «Ό Κύριός μου καί ὁ Θεός μου». Δύο σημεῖα όφείλουμε νά προσέζουμε σ' αὐτή τήν ὁμολογία: α) Ὁ ἀπόστολος Θωμᾶς δέν ἐπισημαίνει ἀπλῶς τήν ταυτότητα τοῦ Άναστάντος Κυρίου με τόν Ίησοῦ Χριστό, ἀλλά καί ἀναγνωρίζει τήν θεότητά Του. β) Η άναγνώριση αὐτή δέν είναι γενική, ἀλλά ἔγει τόν γαρακτήρα τῆς προσωπικῆς σγέσεως καί τῆς ὑπαρζιακῆς τοποθετήσεως. Ύπάρχουν, ἴσως, στιγμές πού καί έμεῖς ὡς ἄνθρωποι ἀτελεῖς καί ἀδύναμοι, κλεινόμαστε στίς δικές μας σκέψεις καί ψάχνουμε τόν Χριστό μακριά ἀπό τήν Έκκλησία Του ή ζητᾶμε σημεῖα γιά νά πιστέψουμε. Γιά νά ἀποφύγουμε αὐτό τόν πειρασμό, ἡ Ἐκκλησία μᾶς διδάσκει ὅτι τήν παρουσία τοῦ Χριστοῦ τήν βιώνουμε σέ τρεῖς εὐλογημένες καταστάσεις: Πρῶτον, στήν τήρηση τῶν ἐντολῶν τοῦ Χριστοῦ. Ἄν θέλουμε δηλαδή να γνωρίσουμε τόν Χριστό, ὑπάρχει μόνο μία ὁδός, ἡ ὁδός τῶν ἐντολῶν. Όποιος δεχτεῖ τόν σταυρό Του, πού εἶναι τό κεφάλαιο ὅλων τῶν ἐντολῶν, αὐτός βρίσκει τήν δόζα Του. Δεύτερον, μέ τήν συμμετοχή μας στά ἱερά Μυστήρια. Δέν εἶναι τυχαῖο τό γεγονός ὅτι ἡ θεία Λειτουργία τελειώνει μέ τήν ὁμολογία πού ψάλλει ὅλη ἡ σύναζη: «Εἴδομεν τό φῶς...». Δέν εἶναι ἀπλῶς ποιητικός ὁ λόγος. Είναι ή πλήρης καί ἰσχυρή βεβαίωση αὐτοῦ πού αὐθεντικά ἔχουμε βιώσει.

ST. NICHOLAS TREE OF LIFE



This sign will be a mosaic sign with an icon of St. Nicholas at its center. Mosaic is a traditional way of making icons or designs using small stone and glazed glass fragments. This technique is centuries old and will last well into our future.




\$1,250,000 PHASE 3: ADDRESSING CRITICAL ROOF REPAIRS – PROTECT OUR SPACES! (2025-2026)
