EPISTLE READING (Heb. 11:33 – 40; 12:1 – 2)

Brethren, all the saints through faith conquered kingdoms, enforced justice, received promises, stopped the mouths of lions, quenched raging fire, escaped the edge of the sword, won strength out of weakness, became mighty in war, put foreign armies to flight. Women received their dead by resurrection. Some were tortured, refusing to accept release, that they might rise again to a better life. Others suffered mocking and scourging, and even chains and imprisonment. They were stoned, they were sawn in two, they were tempted, they were killed with the sword; they went about in skins of sheep and goats, destitute, afflicted, ill-treated — of whom the world was not worthy — wandering over deserts and mountains and in dens and caves of the earth. And all these, though well attested by their faith, did not receive what was promised, since God had foreseen something better for us, that apart from us they should not be made perfect. Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin that easily distracts, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus the pioneer and perfecter of faith.

Jesus said to them, "Truly, I say to you, in the new world, when the Son of man shall sit on his glorious throne, you who have followed me will also sit on twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel. And every one who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or children or lands, for my name's sake, will receive a hundredfold, and inherit eternal life. But many that are first will be last, and the last first."



We kindly ask that you consider to support the renovation for the future and continue to pass the torch of Orthodox faith and Hellenism to future generations to come. Thank you!



\$320,000 PHASE 1: HEATING & AIR CONDITIONING UPGRADE COMPLETE!

The church, chapel, and school buildings now benefit from new, efficient heating and air conditioning systems. Aging, inefficient units, some over 50 years old, have been replaced. This project ensures comfortable and reliable temperatures for worship, education, and community gatherings. We secured the best value through a competitive bidding process involving over a dozen contractors.



\$230,000 PHASE 2: TRANSFORMING OUR PARISH LOBBY – SUMMER RENOVATION!

This summer, we will revitalize our parish lobby, the welcoming heart of our community. This essential space, used daily by church and school parishioners alike, will undergo a complete renovation. Imagine: new ceilings, terrazzo flooring, lighting, a modern reception desk, and updated storefronts and doors. This \$230,000 investment will create a warm and inviting first impression for all who enter.




\$1,250,000 PHASE 3: ADDRESSING CRITICAL ROOF REPAIRS – PROTECT OUR SPACES! (2025-2026)

We are prioritizing the repair and replacement of the church and chapel domes, as well as aging flat roofs. These roofs are reaching the end of their lifespan, and we are seeing evidence of water damage that threatens our iconography and building integrity. Due diligence is underway, with the goal of awarding a contract by the end of the year. This crucial project is estimated to cost approximately \$1,250,000.



Looking to the future, we envision a revitalized complex. Monies permitting, Phase 4 will focus on beautifying our spaces and enhancing functionality. Potential projects include exterior mosaics, brick repointing, window replacements, bathroom renovations, and other church and school upgrades. This ambitious phase, estimated at \$700,000, will create a more welcoming and inspiring environment for our entire community.




