APOLYTIKION

Then the powers of the heavens cried out to You, O Giver of Life, and shouted, "Glory to Your resurrection, O Christ! Glory to Your eternal rule! Glory to Your plan for saving us, only benevolent God!!

APOLYTIKION OF SAINT NICHOLAS

A model of faith and the image of gentleness, the example of your life has shown you forth to your sheep-fold to be a master of temperance. You obtained thus through being lowly, gifts from on high, and riches through poverty, Nicholas, our father and priest of priests, intercede with Christ our God that He may save our souls.

On this day the Virgin Maid goes to the grotto to give birth to the pre-eternal Word in an ineffable manner. Dance for joy, all the inhabited earth, on hearing. Glorify along with Angels and with the shepherds Him who willed that He appear as a newborn Child, the pre-eternal God.

EPISTLE READING (Eph. 5:8 – 19)

Brethren, walk as children of light (for the fruit of the Spirit is found in all that is good and right and true), and try to learn what is pleasing to the Lord. Take no part in the unfruitful works of darkness, but instead expose them. For it is a shame even to speak of the things that they do in secret; but when anything is exposed by the light it becomes visible, for anything that becomes visible is light. Therefore it is said, "Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and Christ shall give you light." Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise men but as wise, making the most of the time, because the days are evil. Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is. And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery; but be filled with the Spirit, addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with all your heart.

GOSPEL READING (LK. 13:10 – 17)

At that time, Jesus was teaching in one of the synagogues on the sabbath. And there was a woman who had a spirit of infirmity for eighteen years; she was bent over and could not fully straighten herself. And when Jesus saw her, he called her and said to her, “Woman, you are freed from your infirmity.” And he laid his hands upon her, and immediately she was made straight, and she praised God. But the ruler of the synagogue, indignant because Jesus had healed on the sabbath, said to the people, “There are six days on which work ought to be done; come on those days and be healed, and not on the sabbath day.” Then the Lord answered him, “You hypocrites! Does not each of you on the sabbath untie his ox or his donkey from the manger, and lead it away to water it? And ought not this woman, a daughter of Abraham whom Satan bound for eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day?” As he said this, all his adversaries were put to shame; and all the people rejoiced at all the glorious things that were done by him.



The Secret Gift of Saint Nicholas

A long, long time ago, there lived a kind bishop named **Nicholas** in a city called Myra. He loved God very much and always wanted to help people.

Nicholas heard about a poor father who had three daughters. They were very sad because the father did not have enough **money** for their clothes and food. Nicholas knew he had to help, but he did not want anyone to know it was him! He wanted the gift to come from God.

So, one night, when everyone was fast asleep, Nicholas crept to the poor family's house. He took three bags filled with bright **gold coins** and secretly dropped them through an open window!

The next morning, the father and his three daughters woke up and found the gold! They were so happy! They used the money to buy food and clothing and felt very blessed.

Saint Nicholas showed us that the best way to live is by being **generous** and helping those in need, even in a secret way. We remember him every year, especially as the protector of sailors and a friend to all children!

Discovering Orthodoxy Class:

A catechism for Orthodox and those inquiring about the faith

Catechism is Christian instruction which includes lessons on the history, teachings and spiritual practices of the Orthodox Christian Church.

What is Orthodoxy?

Where did it come from?

What does it mean to live as an Orthodox Christian today?
