## **EPISTLE READING (Rom. 10:11 – 21; 11:1 – 2)**

Brethren, the scripture says, "No one who believes in God will be put to shame." For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; the same Lord is Lord of all and bestows his riches upon all who call upon him. For, "every one who calls upon the name of the Lord will be saved." But how are men to call upon him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without a preacher? And how can men preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach good news!" But they have not all obeyed the gospel; for Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed what he has heard from us?" So faith comes from what is heard, and what is heard comes by the preaching of Christ. But I ask, have they not heard? Indeed they have; for "Their voice has gone out to all the earth, and their words to the ends of the world." Again I ask, did Israel not understand? First Moses says, "I will make you jealous of those who are not a nation; with a foolish nation I will make you angry." Then Isaiah is so bold as to say, "I have been found by those who did not seek me; I have shown myself to those who did not ask for me." But of Israel he says, "All day long I have held out my hands to a disobedient and contrary people." I ask, then, has God rejected his people? By no means! I myself am an Israelite, a descendant of Abraham, a member of the tribe of Benjamin. God has not rejected his people whom he foreknew.

At that time, as Jesus was walking along, he saw a man called Matthew sitting at the tax office; and he said to him, "Follow me." And he rose and followed him. And as he sat at table in the house, behold, many tax collectors and sinners came and sat down with Jesus and his disciples. And when the Pharisees saw this, they said to his disciples, "Why does your teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?" But when he heard it, he said, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. Go and learn what this means, 'I desire mercy, and not sacrifice.' For I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance."



Matthew's Great Trade: A Story for Kids

Once upon a time, there was a man named Levi. Most people knew him as Levi, but after he met Jesus, he became known as Matthew. Before his great adventure started, Matthew had a busy job: he was a publican, sitting at his booth by the road collecting money.

His booth was called the custom house. Day after day, he would sit there counting coins, and he often felt very lonely.

One sunny morning, Jesus walked right past the custom house and looked at Matthew. "Follow Me," Jesus said.

Matthew didn't hesitate for a second. He left all his money behind and jumped up! He joined Jesus and became one of the Twelve Apostles.


Matthew was now an Evangelist, which means he was a messenger of the best news ever—the Evangelion! He helped share the story of Jesus with everyone.

When Matthew first wrote down his Gospel, he wrote it in Aramaic, the language many people spoke at the time. Later, it was shared and translated into Greek so the whole world could read it.

Matthew's preaching took him far away, even to places like Ethiopia. He shared God's love with everyone he met.

Because Matthew wrote the Gospel that shows Jesus's human family and how he was sent to save us, his special symbol in church art is the angel (or a winged man).

The Church remembers and honors Saint Matthew's life every year on November sixteen. He taught us that no matter how ordinary your job might be, when Jesus calls, you should follow!
