EPISTLE READING (Eph. 5:8 – 19)

Brethren, walk as children of light (for the fruit of the Spirit is found in all that is good and right and true), and try to learn what is pleasing to the Lord. Take no part in the unfruitful works of darkness, but instead expose them. For it is a shame even to speak of the things that they do in secret; but when anything is exposed by the light it becomes visible, for anything that becomes visible is light. Therefore it is said, “Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and Christ shall give you light.” Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise men but as wise, making the most of the time, because the days are evil. Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is. And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery; but be filled with the Spirit, addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with all your heart.

GOSPEL READING (LK. 8:41 – 56)

At that time, there came to Jesus a man named Jairus, who was a ruler of the synagogue; and falling at Jesus' feet he besought him to come to his house, for he had an only daughter, about twelve years of age, and she was dying. As he went, the people pressed round him. And a woman who had had a flow of blood for twelve years and had spent all her living upon physicians and could not be healed by anyone, came up behind him, and touched the fringe of his garment; and immediately her flow of blood ceased. And Jesus said, "Who was it that touched me?" When all denied it, Peter said, "Master, the multitudes surround you and press upon you!" But Jesus said, "Some one touched me; for I perceive that power has gone forth from me." And when the woman saw that she was not hidden, she came trembling, and falling down before him declared in the presence of all the people why she had touched him, and how she had been immediately healed. And he said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well; go in peace." While he was still speaking, a man from the ruler's house came and said, "Your daughter is dead; do not trouble the Teacher any more." But Jesus on hearing this answered him, "Do not fear; only believe, and she shall be well." And when he came to the house, he permitted no one to enter with him, except Peter and John and James, and the father and mother of the child. And all were weeping and bewailing her; but he said, "Do not weep; for she is not dead but sleeping." And they laughed at him, knowing that she was dead. But taking her by the hand he called, saying, "Child, arise." And her spirit returned, and she got up at once; and he directed that something should be given her to eat. And her parents were amazed; but he charged them to tell no one what had happened.

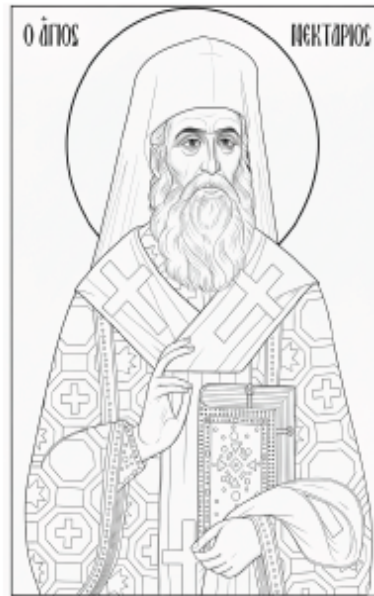

The Kind Bishop: The Story of St. Nektarios

St. Nektarios of Pentapolis was a kind and gentle man who loved God with all his heart. Even when he was young, he cared deeply for others and wanted to help anyone in need. Though he did not have much, he always shared what he could and trusted God to take care of him.

When he grew older, St. Nektarios became a priest, and later a bishop. He taught people to live with faith, patience, and love. Many came to him for advice and felt peace after speaking with him. But not everyone liked his goodness. Some people grew jealous and spread untrue stories about him. Because of this, St. Nektarios lost his position as bishop.

Instead of being angry, he forgave those who had hurt him and continued to thank God. He went to a peaceful island called Aegina, where he worked hard to build a monastery. The nuns there loved him like a father because he was gentle, humble, and always ready to help.

Everyone who met him could feel the kindness of Christ shining through him.

When St. Nektarios became old and sick, he was taken to a hospital. Even there, miracles happened. One man was healed just by touching the saint's clothing. After St. Nektarios fell asleep in the Lord, many people continued to visit his tomb and pray for his help. To this day, he is remembered for his

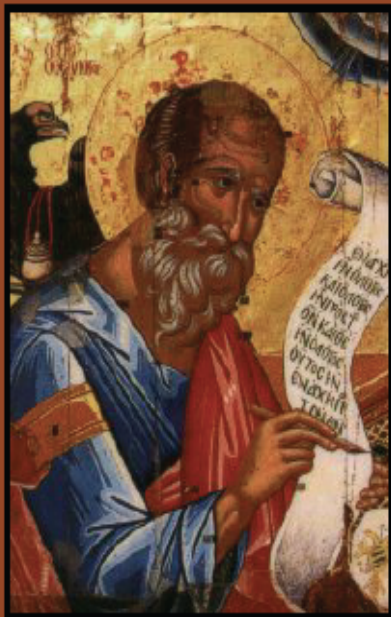

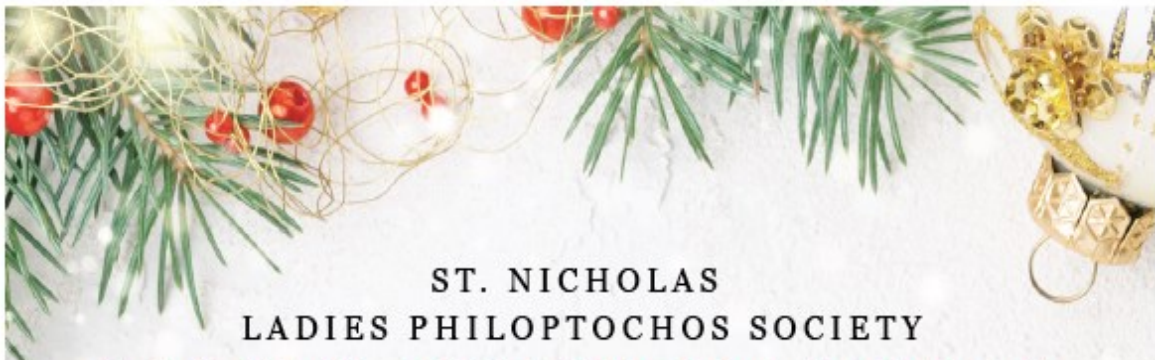
A Special Blessing for our Parishioners on the Occasion of our Holy Anargyroi Chapel Consecration

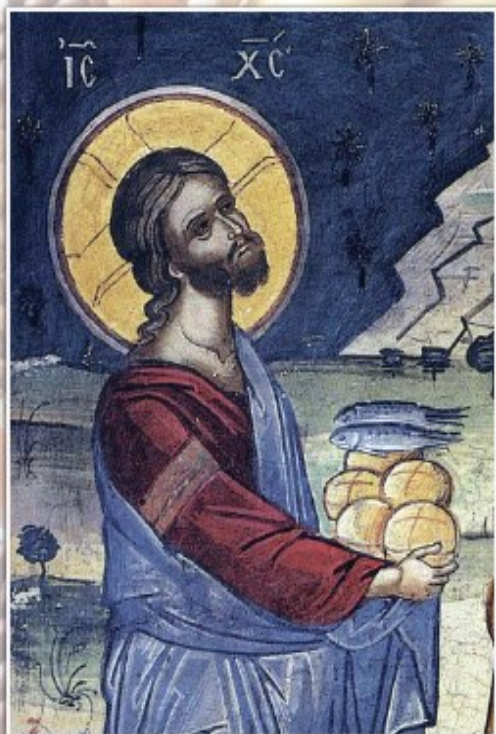
